## What we will be learning:

Math ~ We are learning strategies to help us add and subtract quickly. We have had several lessons on related facts and fact families. We will continue reviewing problem-solving strategies.

We are learning about main idea and supporting details using fiction and nonfictions texts. Please have your child begin thinking about his/her favorite book character for the Literacy Parade on Friday, November 18<sup>th</sup>. You child may dress as his/her favorite character for this event.

Science ~ We will finish the unit on types of energy - sound, light, and heat.

Social Studies ~ We have been discussing the election process and voting (a right and responsibility of American citizens). We have been learning about Veteran's Day and what it means to us and it's importance.
