## What we will be learning:

Math  $\tilde{}$  We are learning different ways to make 10 and 20 using a ten frame, learning to think addition to subtract, and reviewing problem solving strategies.

Language Arts ~ We will continue working on comprehension strategies throughout the year to help us retell a story that we have read. Good readers ask questions before, during and after reading. This strategy helps us remember and understand what we are reading.

Science ~ We are learning about types of energy - sound, light, and heat.

Social Studies ~ We will finish Texas symbols and begin a unit on maps/cardinal directions.
